•Master's degree in a field related to school business + 2 years of experience.

### OR

•Bachelor's degree in a field related to school business + 3 years of experience.

### OR

•7 years as a school business official, based on approval as a seasoned practitioner.

### 2019 VASBO Study Group

- The plans for this year's Study Group are still being developed, but we anticipate a similar structure to last year's group:
  - Several sessions between January 2019 and May 2019
